



Rockers Scholarship Application

South Appleton Rockers Softball Association (SARSA) is proud to award scholarships to graduating high school seniors who have demonstrated a commitment to Appleton East softball and SARSA. Up to \$2,000 in scholarships will be awarded annually, with a \$500 maximum award to any individual.

Applications are due by March 31. Scholarship winners will be notified by April 30.

Eligibility

- Played with SARSA at 3 levels (10U, 12U, 14U, 16U, 18U), a minimum of four total years and two tournaments per year.
- Participated in softball for four years at Appleton East. (Injury is the only exception)
- Maintained academic eligibility for sports participation throughout four years of high school.

Required Information

Applicants need to provide GPA, class rank, and information about their character, involvement in school and the community, volunteer activities and future plans.

Application Process

Applications are accepted from Jan. 1 to March 31. Applications will not be accepted after March 31. Completed applications should be mailed or emailed to:

The amount and number of scholarships is subject to change each year based on approval of the SARSA Board of Directors. Awards are non-renewable and will be awarded to the recipient after completion of one semester of postsecondary education. Recipients must provide a Certificate of Good Standing from their college or a copy of their grades following the first semester of their freshmen year before the scholarship money will be presented.

Financial need is not considered, and no financial statements will be requested. Awards are for undergraduate study and are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion or national origin.
